DATE AND VENUE: The 78th SAMA National Conference will be held at the East London Golf Club from Tuesday 4th November 2014 to Thursday 6th November 2014. This venue is one of the oldest golf clubs in South Africa and rated one of the top ten. The clubhouse has beautiful views of the Indian Ocean, and the dunes and scrubland of Nahoon Beach provide a relaxed atmosphere. Antelope, Vervet Monkeys and an array of bird species complete the picture.
